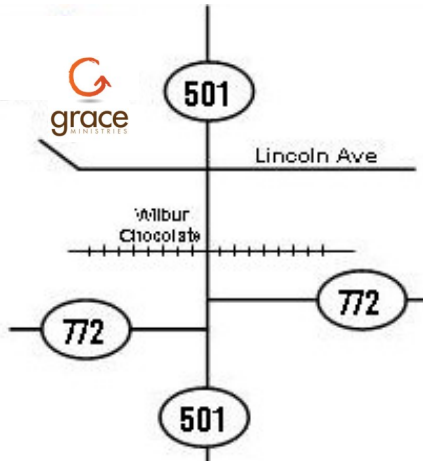

Grace Church has partnered with *Great Food For All*, a faith-based company in Ohio, to provide restaurant-quality frozen and dry food products on a monthly basis to virtually any interested person at a fraction of grocery store prices.

IF YOU EAT...YOU QUALIFY!

How it Works

The Basic Food Box anchors the program and is loaded with enough food to assist in feeding a family of four for about a week, or a single person for almost a month! This food box has a retail value between \$60-\$80 and is provided for only \$30. The Menu changes monthly, providing a variety of items. In addition to the Basic Food, Empty Nester, or Senior Meal Boxes, customers can also order Specialty or Supplemental Boxes. Each Basic Food and Special Box comes pre-packed and ready for delivery.

NO membership fees, NO applications, NO hassles, NO purchase limits, NO end to savings. Just a great deal!

A Hand Up, Not a Hand Out

Orders are placed at Grace Church according to the schedule on the last page. Orders must be pre-paid and a receipt is provided at that time.

We accept cash, money orders, or cashiers' checks at the Grace Church Café. We are pleased to announce that you may also use your Food Stamps Access card for payment as well as Visa, MasterCard, Discover or bank debit card. Online orders can be placed using Visa and MasterCard at the GFFA website (www.greatfoodforall.com).

On Distribution Day, a pre-determined Saturday afternoon once each month, the frozen food arrives at Grace Church. You simply bring your receipt and pick up your food.

Frequently Asked Questions

How much food is in a box?

There are a variety of boxes available but the basic boxes generally provide food to feed a family (2-4 people) a nutritional meal every day for a week.

Will I know the menu in advance?

When you come to pick up your food order on Distribution Day, the next menu will be available for you. For convenience, you will even have an opportunity to place your next order. The menu is also available at the Grace Church Taste of Grace webpage.

Is this program for the poor?

This is a ministry to anyone who eats and is interested in saving money on groceries. This is also a convenient way to help anyone whom you know might be blessed by the gift of basic groceries.

Do I need to qualify for the program?

There are no membership fees or application forms.

How much food may I purchase?

There are no limits to the number of boxes you may order. Order as much as you like, both for your family and for others whom you wish to bless.

How do I place an order?

Orders may be placed at Café @ Grace according to the schedule on the back of this brochure. Additionally, orders may be placed online at www.greatfoodforall.com.

How do I pick up my food?

Orders may be picked up at Grace Church on Distribution Day between the hours of 1:00 - 3:00 pm. Any orders not picked up will be donated toward a local need.
